



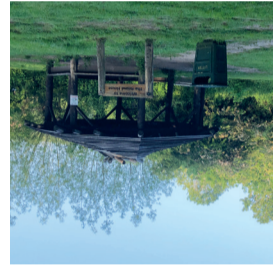
**5. Broadway Community Gardens**

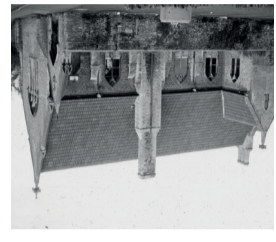
**1. The Good Heart**

**9. The Blue House**  
A home built for the homeless in 1480. Then later rebuilt and became a free school for boys and a home to aged women in need.

**4. SHARE Shop**  
SHARE encourages borrowing to reduce the carbon footprint of Frome. SHARE also provides a community space for people to donate, volunteer, connect, and build skills.

**8. Bennett Centre**  
To improve the education of children, W J E Bennett (leading figure in the Oxford Movement), built the St John's Infant School in 1856 at his own expense.

**11. Mary Baily Playing Fields**  
Mary Baily (1868- 1928) was involved in public and charitable works. Bailey donated the recreation ground which is named in her honour.

**12. Millenium Green**  
Since 2000, in the hands of the Frome Millennium Green Trust, the site has become a natural area, home to wildlife, a community orchard and one of the oldest trees in Frome.

**13. Memorial Theatre**  
The town's war memorial was opened in 1925 to pay tribute to the fallen of World War 1. It was a place used by the people of Frome. It was used as a cinema and later became a theatre in the 1980's.

**14. St Aldhelm's Boys Home**  
Founded in 1897 by the Waifs and Strays Society, it was run by a master and a matron to care for boys aged 10 and 15 boys and provide the basis of a trade for them in printing.

**15. Frome Town Hall**  
Built to give alms to the poor, home now to Frome Town Council, expect a warm welcome, a wealth of signposting knowledge and info, and a safe inclusive space for all.
